

GUIDELINES FOR
AFEO DISTINGUISHED HONORARY FELLOW

Distinguished persons of acknowledged eminence are honoured by awarding the Distinguished Honorary Fellowship to them. It is to be awarded to those persons such as **Deputy/Vice Presidents of a country, Deputy Prime Minister, Heads of Ministry and very prominent persons in high position and rank and world-renowned figures** who have rendered very substantial and outstanding services to the engineering profession, the Institution and/or the ASEAN Nation.

CRITERIA

- i. A distinguished person of acknowledged eminence and high standing very prominent person or engineer of international reputation.
- ii. Has rendered very substantial and outstanding services towards the advancement of the engineering profession.
- iii. Has rendered very substantial and outstanding services that contributes significantly to the attainment of the Vision and Mission of AFEO;
- iv. Has rendered very substantial and outstanding services towards nation building and to the home country(members) of the Board of Governors ;
- v. Has shown outstanding greatness of spirit, integrity and devotion in his service to ASEAN Community;

NUMBER OF NOMINEES

The number of Distinguished Honorary Fellow is limited *to three (3) nominees per country per year.* (Amended at 33rd Governing Board meeting held on 26 November 2015 in Penang, Malaysia)

EXAMPLE OF NOMINEES

1. Deputy/Vice President of the Country
2. Deputy Prime Minister of the Country
3. Ministers/Secretaries
4. Heir to the throne/Regent
5. Princes/Princesses
6. Nobel Laureate

“World Renown Person is defined as “a person of international reputation and a highly honoured and notoriety person of great respect.”
