

World Engineers Summit 2017 – Applied Energy Symposium and Forum: Low Carbon Cities and Urban Energy (WES-CUE 2017) Joint Conference

In July 2017, Singapore will host the World Engineers Summit 2017 – Applied Energy Symposium and Forum: Low Carbon Cities and Urban Energy (WES-CUE 2017) Joint Conference. The World Engineers Summit (WES) biennial conference will continue to champion engineering-led discussions on sustainable urban development while drawing upon the rich technical content of the Applied Energy Symposium and Forum series, to deliver depth and breadth to conference delegates.

On the back of the historic COP 21 agreement made in December 2015, WES-CUE 2017 will provide an important platform for engineers to turn talk into action through the exchange of the latest progress in urban energy systems and policy options in the areas of transport, building, industry, environment, power generation and energy storage.

Since its debut in 2013, the biennial WES has grown to become a global focal point for engineering-led discussions on sustainable urban development. At WES 2015, more than 1,000 engineers and professionals from 38 countries joined sustainability experts to share and exchange best practices and ideas on the theme of sustainable urban development for global climate resilience.

World Engineers Summit 2017 – Applied Energy Symposium and Forum: Low Carbon Cities and Urban Energy (WES-CUE 2017) Joint Conference (Cont.)

Riding on the success of the first two conferences, the third run of WES will continue to anchor on the subject of climate change with a special focus on urban energy systems crucial for a low carbon future. Presented as WES-CUE 2017, the conference is organised by IES in collaboration with the global Applied Energy Symposium and Forum. The three-day event will capture the latest ideas, research findings and best practices on low carbon cities and urban energy.

At WES-CUE 2017, IES will also be introducing the Women in Science, Engineering and Research (WiSER) Forum. The Forum will serve as a platform to raise advocacy for diversity and equality in the engineering profession. It will focus on empowering and promoting women leadership in the engineering industry and professional fields, creating greater awareness of women in the field and promoting this field to aspiring female engineers.

Targeted at women who are current or potential leaders in the field of engineering, science and technology and female students from universities, polytechnics, junior colleges and secondary schools, the WiSER Forum will cover two main segments, namely Women in Engineering and Women in Science and Research. A series of topics ranging from women leadership in the industry and gender diversity to challenges in the field will be touched on. Female leaders who helm these fields will share their experiences and invaluable insights with our participants.

With the increasing number of women joining the engineering, science and research arena, the WiSER Forum will look to acknowledge women's contributions and garner a stronger community in this male-dominated industry.
