MIROS-ARSC had submitted the MOC to MOT for review, and MOT decide to bring the document to (Attorney General's Chambers) AGC, and has to be circulated to Ministry of Finance and Ministry of Foreign Affairs

 - 2 WG, based on the list of topics of RSG (road safety guideline)
 - reported to Task Force
 - Chair: MIROS-ARSC, co-chair by AFEO/MIROS/other related person
 - Members: working level, technical engineers related to the topics.

Action: need AFEO to provide list of nominees

Execution of RSG

Proposed to change to Road Safety Guideline.

The format - may adopt MS format or PIARC road safety manual or a hybrid.

- (h) Effective enforcement for Road safety;
