

## AVENUE OF REPORTING TO THE AFEO GOVERNING BOARD

All affairs of the AER must be reported to the AFEO Governing Board at its meeting. The Head of Register Commission is responsible to report on the AER affairs to the AFEO Governing Board at its Board meeting. The Hon. Secretary of IEM (IEM being the AFEO Hon. Treasurer) had to present the AFEO, and this account would included the AER Accounts, to the AFEO Governing Board at its meeting.

## CHANGES

At the 1st Mid term AFEO Board meeting held on 26 April 2002 at Rangsit University, Pathumthani Thailand, the AFEO Governing Board amended the Constitution to allow for Individual Honorary Members to be included into the membership of AFEO. Various proposals were made to the need to have an independent AER Secretariat as well as the limitation and powers of the Head of the AER and the Register Commission. At the 20<sup>th</sup> AFEO Board meeting in Phnom Penh, Cambodia on 3 September 2002, the call to streamline the working of the AER and the various roles were made. This was thoroughly discussed again at the 2<sup>nd</sup> Mid year AFEO Board meeting in Singapore on 14 March 2003 in which amendments were made to the AFEO Constitution and Bylaws and the Guide to the ASEAN Engineer Register

Changes were made to the various posts in the ASEAN Engineers Register as follows:

National Monitoring Committee (NMC)	Maintained
ASEAN Engineer Register Executive Committee (Exco)	A new Committee was set up
