

GUIDELINES FOR

THE AFEO HONORARY MEMBER

Distinguished persons of acknowledged eminence are honoured by awarding the Honorary Membership to them. It is to be awarded to those persons who had rendered outstanding services to the engineering profession, the Institution and/or the Nation.

PROCEDURE

Nominations for the award are to be made annually at the mid-term Governing Board's Meeting, or wherever the Board of Governors deems fit. They are to be recommended through a member of the Board of Governors.

Each nomination shall be accompanied by a write up of the services and contributions to the profession, the Institution and/or the Nation.

The AFEO Awards Committee appointed by the AFEO Board and chaired by the AFEO Chairman, shall evaluate each nomination and make recommendations. The final decision shall be made by the Board of Governors. The nominee shall not be contacted until the Board of Governors had agreed on the nomination.

The decision shall be by a vote of the Board of Governors where not less than two thirds of the total members present, must be in favour. The number of Honorary Members is limited to a maximum of 10 per country per year. Voting is by secret ballot.

CRITERIA

- i. Have made outstanding contribution to the advancement of the engineering profession, the Institution and/or the Nation.
- ii. Have shown outstanding greatness of spirit, integrity and devotion to the engineering engineering professions and/or the Nation.
- iii. Have shown selfless service without expecting public recognition.
