

GUIDELINES FOR

AFEO HONORARY FELLOW

Distinguished corporate member of members or non-members of acknowledged eminence are honoured by awarding the Honorary Fellowship to them. It is to be awarded to those persons who had rendered outstanding services to the engineering profession, the Institution and/or the Nation.

PROCEDURE

Nominations for the award are to be made annually or whenever the Board of Governors deems fit. They are to be recommended through a member of the Board of Governors.

Each nomination shall be accompanied by a write up of the services and contributions to the profession, the Institution and/or the Nation.

The AFEO Awards Committee shall evaluate each nomination and make recommendations. The final decision shall be made by the Board of Governors. The nominee shall not be contacted until the Board of Governors had agreed on the nomination.

The decision shall be by a vote of the Board of Governors where not less than two thirds of the total members present, must be in favour. The number of Honorary Fellows is limited to five (5) at any one time. Voting is by secret ballot.

CRITERIA

- i. Have contributed to the advancement of the engineering profession, the Institution and/or the Nation.
- ii. Have shown outstanding greatness of spirit, integrity and devotion to the engineering professions, the Institution and/or the Nation.
- iii. Have shown selfless service without expecting public recognition.
