The newly elected committee members of Engineers Division consist Lim Sui Kau, the Vice

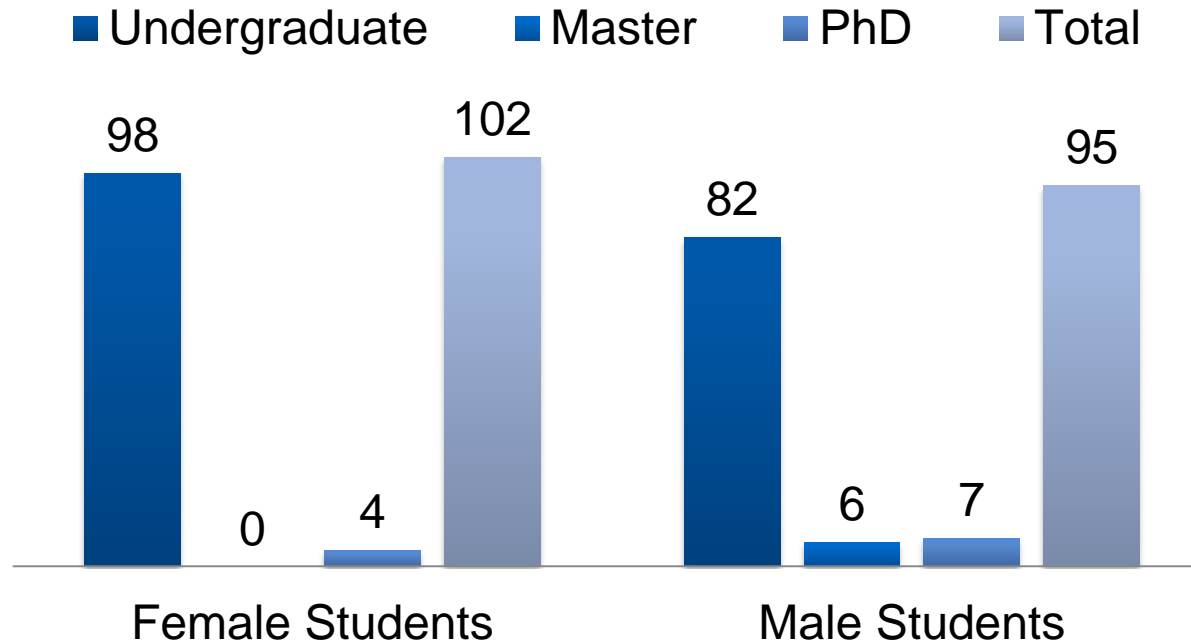

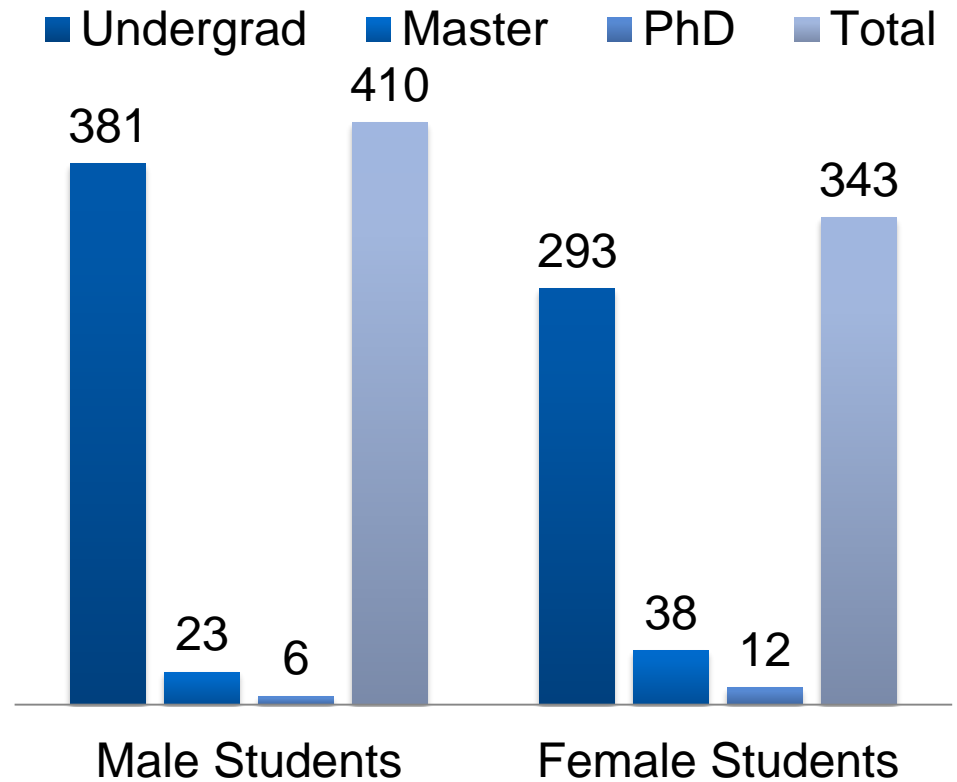

A Brief Overview of the MINISTRY OF DEVELOPMENT'S POLICY FRAMEWORK & STRATEGIC PLAN 2018-2023

THE 5WH OF BIM

Understanding and Implementing BIM

COURSE DETAILS

Before hopping on the bandwagon with the rest of the industry, we must first go back to the roots of this industrial revolution and understand the basis of its conception. In this presentation, we will address the 5WH (When, Where, Why, What, Who, How) questions that revolve around the term Building Information Modelling, otherwise more commonly addressed as BIM.

The origins of BIM to understand when and where the concept was introduced. By doing this, we can then have a better understanding of why BIM was introduced to the industry. We will then ponder on what are the principles that form the basis of BIM.

Address one of the most glaring issue which plagues the industry when it comes to BIM, how to implement BIM? How do we transition from here to there? Who will be in charge of the information for one who is responsible for the management of BIM model? We will also discuss the roles and responsibility of each profession in a BIM environment.

We will then move into the tools that can be used to perform quantity takeoff for building and M&E disciplines. This section will cover how parties involved in a BIM project can collaborate and transfer usable information to complete the project. We will discuss how the right tools and correct procedures can help speed up the working of respective parties and the project team as a whole.

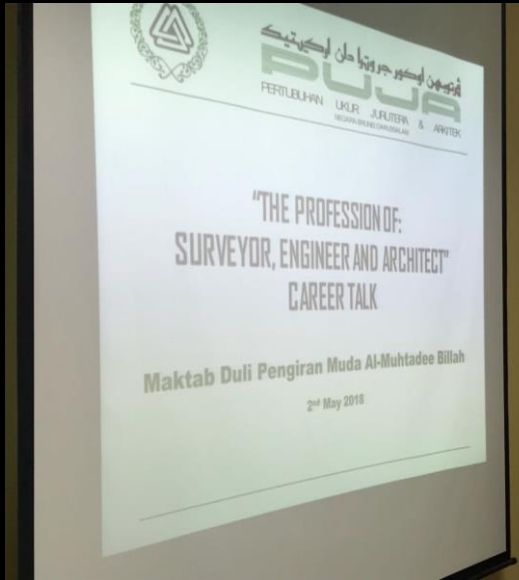

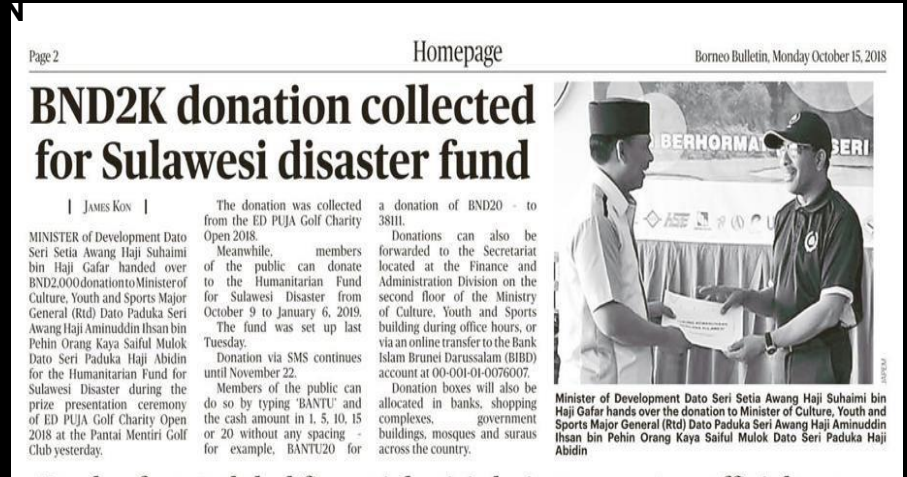

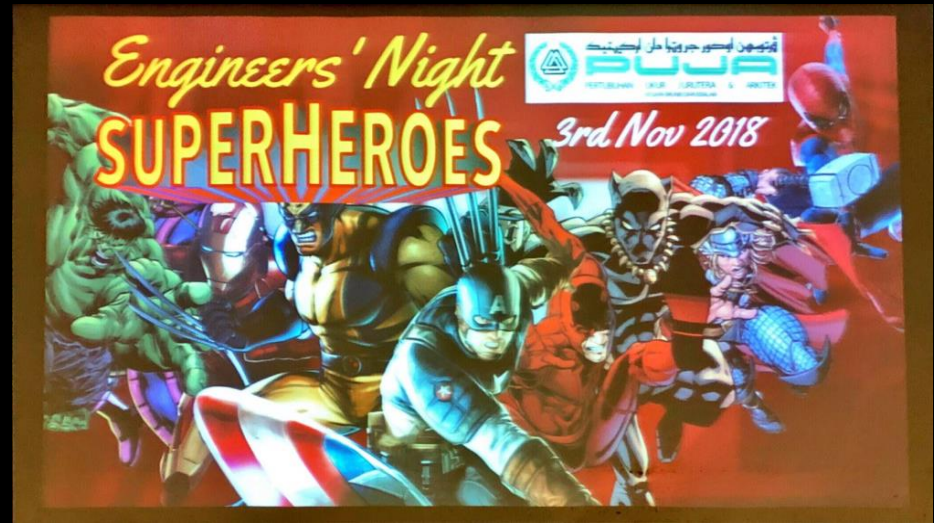
